No rental charge will be levied for use of classrooms or lecture rooms for 1) bona fide group or organizational meetings or one-time events held by student groups officially recognized by the Office of Student Affairs and the Dean of Students, 2) bona fide departmental meetings or one-time events held by university departments as recognized by Old Dominion University's Organizational Chart, or 3) official university events as sanctioned by the Office of University Events. Those individuals, groups, or organizations not meeting the definitions above shall be subject to the following charges for each classroom or lecture hall reserved. Payments shall be made in advance of the event and no food is allowed in the University's classrooms or lecture halls unless provided by the Webb Student Center's catering service.

FOOTNOTES

1 Full-time faculty, faculty administrators and classified employees who have completed one (1) year of employment and whose annual salaries do not exceed \$89,000 are eligible for tuition assistance at Old Dominion University, not to exceed the current in-state tuition rate. Eligible faculty and faculty administrators are eligible for nine (9) credit hours: three (3) credit hours in fall and spring semesters and three (3) credit hours in the summer session. Eligible classified employees are eligible for fifteen (15) credit hours: 6 in fall and spring semesters and three (3) in the summer session.

2 All legal dependents, as defined by current Internal Revenue Service regulations, and spouses of eligible employees are eligible for tuition assistance at Old Dominion University at the current in-state rate: six (6) credit hours in the fall and six (6) in the spring semesters. three credit hours for the summer sessions; classified staff - six (6) credit hours for the fall semester, six (6) credit hours for the spring semester, and three (3) credit hour for the summer sessions.

3 Students from the Armed Forces, area School Boards, and other Virginia employees are granted in-state tuition rates pursuant to Special Arrangement Contracts.

4 Graduate students who are employed as graduate assistants and receiving financial support to pursue graduate degrees at Old Dominion University may receive partial to full tuition assistance. In order to be eligible to receive full tuition assistance, graduate students must be enrolled in and complete at least six hours of graduate course work each semester and three in the summer. To continue receiving tuition assistance, graduate students must be supported for at least one half of the semester and receive at least \$2,500 in support per regular semester or \$1,334 during the summer. A doctoral student who has successfully passed the Candidacy Examination and needs only to complete the dissertation must be registered for at least one hour of dissertation (899) to be eligible for full tuition assistance.

5 Tuition is distributed to the participating institutions based upon the number of credit hours taken by each student at the individual institutions.

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7 The rate does not include an optional health service fee of \$48.00 for the summer session. See Section VI - Health Service Fees.

8 A graduate teaching or research assistant who has completed a master's degree or its equivalent and is admitted as a matriculated student into a doctoral program and enrolls for and completes a minimum of 9 hours of graduate credit per semester or 3 hours in the summer may be granted a waiver of full tuition and fees.

9 Tuition and fee rate charged for TELETECHNET USA.

10 Annual fee charged to all Physical Therapy majors to support the costs associated with the increased demand for graduates of the program.

11 Changes per Commonwealth Accounting Policies and Procedures (CAPP) Manual.

12 Waived for ODU alumni, ODU full-time faculty and staff, ODU full-time employee dependents, matriculated students from undergraduate to graduate, freshmen ATP fee waivers and certain transfer applicants with financial need certifications.

13 Applicable to students accepted in limited access health related programs (i.e., Physical Therapy). Fee is forfeited if student does not attend the program. This fee will be applied to the student's tuition balance.

14 Students participating in the experiential learning portfolio option will be charged a one-time workshop fee and a portfolio assessment fee equal to 50% of the current approved in-state, on-campus rate for undergraduate and graduate courses. Students participating in the experiential learning departmental examination or knowledge-based examination option will be charged an assessment fee equal to 30% of the current approved in-state, on-campus rate for undergraduate and graduate courses. Students requesting evaluation of training not already evaluated by Old Dominion University, will be charged 20% of the current in-state, on-campus rate. Organizations will be charged 80% of the current in-state, on-campus rate.

15 Noncredit class fees and costume rental fees are waived for volunteers and paid professionals in the ODU Ballet Program. This footnote also applies to item numbers 2, 3 and 13.

16 Fees established in Ledger 6 to cover special amenities may also apply ranging from 5.00 - 25.00.

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18 Services to profit-making organization, add 25% administrative fee. For additional information regarding these services, please consult with Academic Technology Services (757) 683-3171 or 683-5486.

19 ODU Faculty, Staff, Students and Senior Citizens (62 years and older) receive \$5.00 discount.

20 Waived for Dental Hygiene Students, severely indigent individuals upon discretion of Director of Clinical Affairs.

21 Waived for indigent individuals upon the discretion of the Director of the Child Study Center.

22 Waived for Speech Pathology students, indigent individuals and individuals who "qualify" to participate in selected demonstration activities upon the discretion of the Director of the Child Study Center.

23 The Foreign Language Test and off-site administration of the Miller Analogies Test are exempt from the test registration fee.

24 Minimum of two technicians for performance.

25 Maximum fine is \$25.00, after which replacement costs apply.

26 If an item is returned, the replacement charge and administrative fee are dropped, but fines are payable. With library approval, new copy of lost material may be accepted in lieu of paying replacement cost. Administrative fee still applies.

27 Replacement cost determined by library staff based on availability and purchase price. ODU reserves the right to bill rare and/or out-of-print materials at actual cost of replacement.

28 Waived for full-time employees and their dependents.

29 Waived for students with full funding for room and board by government or independent agencies if they formally agree to take responsibility for damages.

30 Fee refundable if lease is canceled in writing and received in the Housing Office by May 1 for the fall semester and December 1 for the spring semester.

31 Handicapped students, determined by the University to require a single room, shall be charged the prevailing rate for a student in a double-occupant room. Other students granted single rooms shall be charged the prevailing room rate for a student in a double-occupant room plus an additional \$800.00 per semester.

32 No Fee is charged if; (1) the cardholder's SSN or identification number changes, (2) the status of the cardholder changes to or from student/faculty/staff, (3) the manufacturer produces a defective card, (4) the cardholder has not taken classes for three consecutive semesters (including summer session) or, (5) due to administrative

33 Prorated rebates apply to decal sales.

34 PhD candidates employed by the University in the capacity of instruction may purchase Faculty/Staff hanging decals at the lowest price for the period employed with a letter signed by their Department Chair.

35 The production fee is charged if the yearbook staff is required to produce a track of the advertisement.

36 For student groups recognized by Student Services and University departments, but who sponsor a non-University wide event (closed), as determined by the Director of the Student Center.

37 Cancellation fee would be 25% of the total cost for a ropes course event. Groups that cancel or reschedule a ropes course event 1-14 days ahead of time will be charged 25% (25% of the total course fee plus instructor fees). Groups canceling or rescheduling a ropes course event with less than 24 hours notice will be responsible for paying for the entire event. No adjustments will be made for less participants attending than originally contracted.
