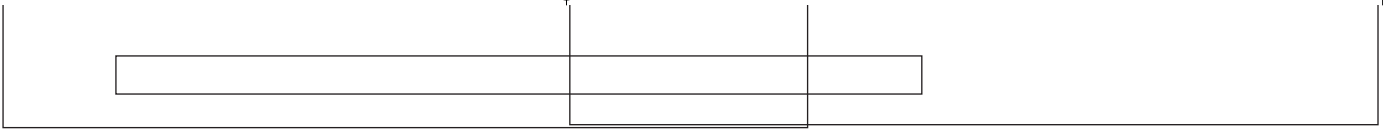

Keep your checklist current and bring it with you to all advising appointments for updating.

This checklist is to be turned in to the Chief Departmental Advisor when you apply for graduation. Requirements for graduation include a minimum of 120 hours, a minimum overall GPA of 2.75 and no less than a "C" in major courses and a "C-" in the professional education core. Transfer students must earn a minimum of 21 credit hours in studio art at ODU for the BA.
