Research Experience for Undergraduates

The Frank Batten College of Engineering and Technology awards research experience grants to its undergraduate students each academic year in the amount of \$1,500 (\$1,000 stipend and \$500 for expenses). The faculty supervisor has the option to add up to \$500 to the stipend from his/her active research grant(s) and/or contract(s). The awardees must express a genuine interest in pursuing their graduate degrees at Old Dominion University. Preference will be given to those applicants enrolled in one of the College's accelerated BS/ME, BS/MS or ET/MD programs.

Applications for these funds will be accepted and reviewed twice a year, and they should be submitted within the first two weeks of the Fall and Spring semesters. The research project duration is normally one year. However, applications for shorter projects will also be given consideration. All BCET undergraduate students who are within 24 months from graduation are eligible.

The application forms are available in the Dean's Office. A summary of the proposed research project not to exceed one typed page should be attached to the application form. This project summary should be prepared by the student applicant in consultation with the proposed faculty supervisor.

The research experience awards will be announced within one week after the application deadline. The awardees are expected to submit a brief report approved by their faculty supervisors at the completion of their projects.
