1040 - USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Statement: Individuals must be 21 years of age to purchase, possess, or consume alcoholic beverages on campus. Drinking in public (other than licensed, outdoor areas) and being intoxicated in public are violations of the Beverage Control Act and the Code of Student Conduct. The service, use, or possession of alcoholic beverages on university owned or controlled property or at functions sponsored by the University or by university recognized student organizations is prohibited unless such service, use, or possession is strictly in accordance with the statutes and regulations of the Commonwealth of Virginia and with university policies and procedures implementing such statutes and regulations. The President shall have the responsibility of enforcing this regulation of the Board of Visitors and promulgating and enforcing university policies and procedures implementing this regulation.

Licenses acquired on behalf of the University from the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission shall be acquired upon application of the President or the President's designated representative.

For those student events which are permissible under this policy, the Vice President for Student Services will issue procedures to govern these events.
