APRIL 2008

- 14–18 Summer/Fall 2008 pre-registration for currently registered degree-seeking students (Monday-Friday)
 19 Summer/Fall 2008 open registration begins for all students (Saturday)

JUNE

- 30 Deadline for applications for graduation December 2008 (Monday)

AUGUST

- 14 **TUITION DEADLINE** (Thursday)
 22 Summer 2008 Graduation Date (*no ceremony*)**
 23 Fall 2008 Classes begin (Saturday)
Deadline to apply for in-state tuition rates for Fall 2008 classes
 29 **Last day to DROP** a course with no grade assigned (Session 1 and 2 classes) (Friday)*
Last day to DROP and receive full tuition refund or credit (Session 1 and 2 classes) (Friday)*
