Program 352-L: Secondary School-Library Science/Media

For teachers who currently have, or are eligible for, a Virginia teaching license for grades 7-12 and wish to earn a M.S.Ed. and obtain licensure as a school librarian for grades NK-12.

 [6 credits] Taken after completion of library courses

Area II: Support [3-9 credits]

Based on a student's background and job preferences, additional courses in elementary/middle school education or secondary education may be suggested or required by the advisor or graduate program director. This may raise the number of hours necessary to obtain the degree. ECI 543 and/or ECI 530 may count in Area II.
