## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. A Miller Analogy Test (MAT) score of at least 45 or a combined score of 900 on the verbal and quantitative sub-test on the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is required for official admittance. Call University Testing Center (683-3697) for information packet, dates, and times.
2. No more than 12 credits can be taken as a non-degree student. University policies governing transfer of credits from non-degree status will apply and only courses with a grade of B or better are eligible.
3. An applicant should have a grade point average of 3.0 in the undergraduate major and 2.5 in cumulative course work on a 4.0 scale.
4. Provisional admission may be granted to applicants whose grades or scores fall slightly below the required cut-offs.
5. Graduate comprehensive exam required after at least five graduate classes have been completed. Application is due 30 days prior to the October or March examination dates. There are no summer examinations.
6. All graduate course work must be completed within 6 years of initial enrollment in graduate classes.
7. Read the course descriptions and prerequisites in the Old Dominion University Catalog.
8. Apply for graduation the semester prior to student teaching.
9. Apply for student teaching by submitting the Application for Student Teaching Form by the date designated on the application issued by the Office of Teacher Education Services at Old Dominion University.
10. All course work in sections A & B should be completed before student teaching.
11. Review the Old Dominion University Catalog for more detailed information.
