ODU School of Dental Hygiene and EVMS HOPES Clinica Esperanza Partner to Provide Free Services to ESL Children



Old Dominion University's Gene W. Hirschfeld School of Dental Hygiene recently partnered with Eastern Virginia Medical School's HOPES Clinica Esperanza to provide free services to children for whom English is a second language.

Youths ages 4 to 13, whose parents signed their children up for a referral from the HOPES Free Clinic, received dental assessments, X-rays, teeth cleanings, fluoride varnish applications

and preventative sealants on Nov. 5 at ODU's David and Sofia Konikoff Dental Hygiene Care Facility, which is in the College of Health Sciences.

A total of 26 ODU dental hygiene students provided the treatment under the supervision of licensed dental hygiene faculty, which included Associate Professor and School Chair Ann Bruhn, Senior Lecturer/Dentist Lee Melvin, Assistant Professor Emily Ludwig, Lecturer Adaira Howell, Director of Clinical Affairs Lauren Eusner and adjunct faculty member Samantha Vest. Graduate teaching assistant Monica Puentes also participated.

Featured Student: Nicole Parham



Time hasn't always been on Nicole Parham's side.

Her working life has been shaped by moves for her husband's service in the U.S. Coast Guard, pregnancies, a historic flood and a pandemic.

But at 46, Parham feels she has found the career she was meant to pursue. On Dec. 17, Parham will graduate from Old Dominion

University with a bachelor's degree in medical laboratory science - completed in less than two years while working for Sentara Healthcare, serving as the program's class president and raising two daughters.

It's a surprising path for Parham, who swore she'd never pursue a career in health care based on her experiences growing up in the Navajo Nation in New Mexico.

"Every experience that I've had with Indian Health Services were about a lack of resources," she said. "If you had an appointment, you knew you'd be waiting all day."
