## CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The cumulative grade point average (GPA) Is determined by dividing the total grade points earned by the total credit hours attempted. The example below, based on a single semester, illustrates that 34 divided by 15 equals a GPA of 2.26. (GPA's are truncated, NOT rounded.) All grades received during a student's enrollment (except the grades of W. P. Z. and F in a Pass/Fail course) are included in the cumulative GPA. Grades from other colleges are excluded.
