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- infinitive mood  $\Rightarrow$  the mood of unconjugated verbs
- verbal aspect  $\Rightarrow$  expresses how an action, event, or state, denoted by a verb, extends over time (e.g. progressive, stative, inchoative, iterative, perfective, imperfective, etc.
