salvēre, salvē, salvēte

The the 2nd conjugation verb *salvēre*, meaning “to be well, to be in good health”, is defective. In grammatical terms a verb is defective when it lacks some of its forms. This verb is defective because it lacks all forms but the imperative and infinitive forms. For now, you will see it mostly in the imperative used as a greeting:

- Pater filiōs salūtat: “Salvēte, filiī!” et ā filiīs salūtātur: “Salvē, pater!” [ll.31–32]

The the 2nd conjugation verb *salvēre*, meaning “to be well, to be in good health”, is defective. In grammatical terms a verb is defective when it lacks some of its forms. This verb is defective because it lacks all forms but the imperative and infinitive forms. For now, you will see it mostly in the imperative used as a greeting:

- Pater filiōs salūtāt: “Salvēte, filiī!” et ā filiīs salūtātur: “Salvē, pater!” [ll.31–32]

The father greets his sons: “Hello, sons!” and is greeted by his sons: “Hello, father!”

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Notā bene: English can express the indirect object either with a preposition or with word order, as you can see in the alternate translations in parentheses.

reflexive pronoun *sē*

The third person accusative/ablative reflexive pronoun sē is used to reflect the action back on the subject of the sentence. That is the subject does something to herself or is the object of a preposition in the same clause. Consider the following sentences:
