**Recēnsiō (review)**

**Written Exam.** The exam will consist of three parts.

- I. *Studia Rōmāna* & Culture. (multiple choice and true/false)
  - A. Be sure that you can find the major rivers territories, islands, and Rome(!) on a map.
  - B. Know the main points of the *Stūdia Rōmana* sections in **COMP**.
  - C. Know how to answer questions such as those in Cap. I, *pēnsūm C*.
- II. Pronunciation/Grammar/Vocabulary (fill-in-the-blank, short answer, or multiple choice)
  - A. Know how the consonants, vowels, and diphthongs are pronounced.
  - B. Know how to do all the exercises from the first three chapters, but pay particular attention to the following:
    1. ii-8
    2. ii-9
    3. iii-4
    4. iii-6
    5. iii-7
    6. iii-9
    7. all the *pēnsa A* and *B*
  - C. Know the cases (nominative, accusative, genitive), their forms, and how/why they are used.
  - D. Know how to use *est* and *sunt* and all the other verbs.
- III. Reading (unseen text, featuring the same vocab and characters from **FR**)
  - A. You will be asked to answer questions in English about the story you read.
  - B. You will be asked to translate a couple of sentences into English.
  - C. You will be asked identify the gender, number, and case of certain nouns.
  - D. You will be asked to give a reason why certain items are in a certain case (i.e., subject, object, possession/origin, etc).
