double accusative

The verb *docēre* can take two accusatives. The first accusative is the person being taught, the second is the thing being taught:

double accusative

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- Magister discipulōs linguam latīnam docet.

adverbia

Regular adverbs can be formed from 2-1-2 adjectives by adding $-ē$ to the stem:

- $rēctus, -a, -um \Rightarrow$
- $stultus, -a, -um \Rightarrow$
- $prāvus, -a, -um \Rightarrow$
- $aequus, -a, -um \Rightarrow$

adverbia

Regular adverbs can be formed from 2-1-2 adjectives by adding *-ē* to the stem:

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- *rēctus*, -a, -um ⇒ *rēctē* *rightly, correctly*
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- *aequus*, -a, -um ⇒ *aequē*

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- *prāvus*, -a, -um ⇒ *prāvē* *incorrectly, wrongly*
- *aequus*, -a, -um ⇒ *aequē* *equally, fairly*

numeri

- Cardinal numbers are numbers like 1, 2, 3...

numerī

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- The only cardinal numbers that decline are *ūnus*, *-a*, *um*, *duo*, *duae*, *duo*, *trēs*, *tria*, and multiples of 100 (*ducentī*, *-ae*, *-a*, *trecentī*, *-ae*, *-a*, etc.). See page 149 of the *Companion*.
