

Internship/Coop Credits For Mechanical Engineering Technology

Students holding full-time employment positions in the field of mechanical engineering or related field may be able to obtain college credit using Internship and/or Coop Education. Interested students must apply following the instructions noted below. All forms, costs associated with this route, and detailed information can be found at the website noted below. Upon review of the application documents, the Career Development Services (CDS) Office and the MET Program Director will determine eligibility into this program.

Procedure:

- (1) Initiate process directly with the Career Development Services Office

- (2) Complete application form with CDS Office
- (3) Submit copy of updated resume to determine how your working experience qualifies for Internship/Coop credits
- (4) Review process takes place
- (5) Upon approval students shall register in three consecutive semesters at 1 credit level each
- (6) Three internship/coop credits are used in lieu of one approved MET 400 level senior elective
- (7) A maximum of six internship/coop credits or two courses is allowed per student
