**Note:** Completion of the AS in Behavior Sciences is required for this articulation agreement. Students who do not complete the ABS at Richard Bland College will need to successfully complete all lower-level general education courses required of ODU graduates.

Requirements for graduation include completion of at least 120 credit hours with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major. Students must also have a minimum of 25% of the required credit hours completed at Old Dominion University, at least 12 of which are upper-level major courses. They are required to complete ENGL 110C and ENGL 211C, 221C or 231C, and the writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of C or better. Finally, students are required to complete the Senior Assessment prior to graduation.
