- 1. If student took Dental Assisting Courses: DNA 110 instead of DNH 214, DNA 130 instead of DNH 230 and/or DNA 134 instead of DNH 130, they will receive GNRL 1ELE credit instead of HLTH 1ELE or HLTH 2ELE credit. Students with DNA courses would have a total of 70-72 credits instead of 70 from the AAS degree.
- 2. Choose a course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <a href="http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-quide.html">http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-quide.html</a> in the following categories: 3 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, or Foreign Language. Also ensuring these courses fulfills the electives required for the AAS.
- 3. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <a href="http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html">http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html</a> 6 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.
- 4. Transfer credit for DNA 110 is 3 credits instead of DNH 214 2 credits, so this elective would not be required in such case.

## Notes (continued):

- Before taking DNTH courses, students must have a current CPR certificate (renewed biannually).
- Credit hours from the Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene programs are used to satisfy the BSDH Post-licensure Online Program as academic electives.
- > Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit from AAS courses and all Dental Hygiene courses at ODU require a C or higher grade as well.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2022-2023 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2024, unless an updated agreement quide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs.
