- > Students must complete general education requirements and STAT 130M with a grade of C or better before applying for admission to the BSHS Health Services Administration Professional program. Admission is conducted on a rolling basis. Students who have met all program admissions requirements will be referred by their advisor in the Health Sciences Advising Center/ODU Online Health Sciences advisor to the program director for major declaration, program admission and assignment to a program advisor.
