Upper Division General Education is satisfied by the required minor in health education included in the program (Option A) and completion of professional education courses (Option C).

\*Teacher candidates intending to teach in a secondary setting MUST complete an endorsement area in Driver's Education, which requires 6 additional hours (PE 308 and 309). Teacher candidates seeking a Coaching Education minor will need SMT/PE 415, SMT/PE 456, and PE 368 (Coaching Internship). Consult with advisor and University Catalog.

Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 overall and in the major, a grade of C or better in all courses required for the major, including prerequisite courses, 123 credit hours, which must include both a minimum of 31 credit hours overall and 12 credit hours in upper-level courses in the major program from Old Dominion University, completion of ENGL 110C, ENGL 211C or 221C or 231C, and a writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of C or better, and completion of Senior Assessment.
