Bachelor of Science Special Education Early Childhood (birth-5) and Adapted Curriculum (K-12)

NOTE: Majors must have a minimum 2.8 GPA (overall, within major coursework, and within professional education coursework), a grade of C or better in all courses, and meet the Praxis requirement to be admitted to the undergraduate teacher education program. All students must apply for and be admitted into the undergraduate teacher education program by their 60th credit hour and/or prior to the start of her or his junior year. Delaying admission to the undergraduate teacher education program will adversely affect your ability to complete this program in 4 years. Please refer to the catalog and consult your advisor for additional requirements, prerequisites, and eligibility for teacher licensure in Virginia.

Upper Division General Education is satisfied through professional education sequence.

*Majors must complete one Lecture/Lab course in BIOL and one Lecture/Lab course in either PHYS (preferred) or CHEM.

**UTEP Admission Interviews are currently only required for students in Hampton Roads.

Once a candidate is cleared by ODU, additional clearance background check will not be required unless there is a break in enrollment at ODU that requires the candidate to go through reactivation or readmission process with the Old Dominion University admissions office.
