NOTE: Majors must have a minimum 2.8 GPA (overall, within major coursework, and within professional education coursework), a grade of C or better in all courses, and pass the VBOE teacher prep entry assessment to be admitted to the undergraduate teacher education program. All students should apply for and be admitted into the undergraduate teacher education program by their 60th credit hour. Delaying admission to the undergraduate teacher education program will adversely affect your ability to complete this program in 4 years. Please refer to the catalog and consult your advisor for additional requirements, prerequisites, and eligibility for teacher licensure in Virginia.

Upper Division General Education is satisfied through professional education sequence.

*UTEP Admission Interviews are currently only required for students in Hampton Roads. This program is not offered online.

Majors must apply, be admitted, and complete the 5th year graduate program before being eligible for licensure. Graduate students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and have all coursework completed with at least a B- grade

^Once a candidate is cleared by ODU, additional clearance background check will not be required unless there is a break in enrollment at ODU that requires the candidate to go through reactivation or readmission process with the Old Dominion University admissions office.
