Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major and minor, 120 credit hours, which must include both a minimum of 30 credit hours overall and 12 credit hours in upper-level courses in the major program from Old Dominion University, completion of all general education requirements including ENGL 110C and ENGL 211C or ENGL 221C with a grade of C (2.0) or better, completion of all major requirements including the writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of C (2.0) or better, and completion of the Senior Assessment.
