Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major, a grade of C- (1.7) or better in all PRTS core courses and PRTS 271 required for the major, 120 credit hours, which must include both a minimum of 30 credit hours overall and 12 credit hours in upper-level courses in the major program from Old Dominion University, completion of ENGL 110C, ENGL 211C or 221C or 231C, and a writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of C (2.0) or better, and completion of Senior Assessment.
