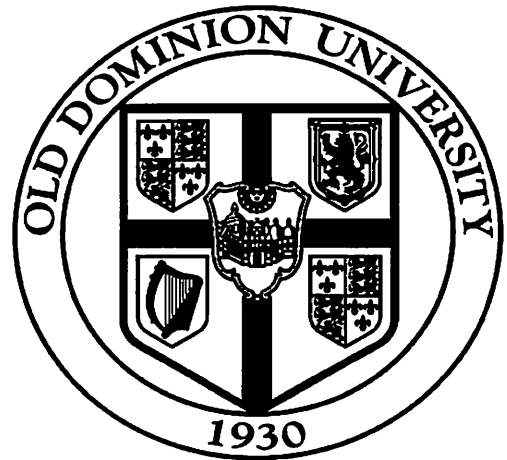

Payments shall be made in advance of the event and no food is allowed in the University's classrooms or lecture halls unless provided by the Webb Student Center's catering service.

- 1 Full-time faculty, faculty administrators and classified employees who have completed one (1) year of employment and whose annual salaries do not exceed \$89,000 are eligible for tuition assistance at Old Dominion University, not to exceed the current in-state tuition rate. Eligible faculty and faculty administrators are eligible for nine (9) credit hours: three (3) credit hours in fall and spring semesters and three (3) credit hours in the summer session. Eligible classified employees are eligible for fifteen (15) credit hours: 6 in fall and spring semesters and three (3) in the summer session.
- 2 All legal dependents, as defined by current Internal Revenue Service regulations, and spouses of eligible employees are eligible for tuition assistance at Old Dominion University at the current in-state rate: six (6) credit hours in the fall and six (6) in the spring semesters.
- 3 Students from the Armed Forces, area School Boards, and other Virginia employees are granted in-state tuition rates a flat military rate pursuant to Special Arrangement Contracts.
- 4 Graduate students who are supported through graduate assistantships and appointed as Graduate Assistants are required to be enrolled during the semester of their appointment, but their registration requirements may differ based on their funding sources, duties, and/or residency status:

**Graduate Teaching Assistants and Graduate Administrative Assistants**

Graduate Teaching Assistants, including both GTA-Instructors and GTA-Assistants, and Graduate Administrative Assistants who are paid from non-restrictive Commonwealth funds must register for and complete a minimum of nine (9) hours of graduate coursework per fall and spring semesters and three (3) hours of graduate coursework per summer semester. Graduate Teaching Assistants and Graduate Administrative Assistants who are paid from restrictive Commonwealth (S5) funds must register for and complete a minimum of nine (9) hours of graduate coursework per fall and spring semesters and six (6) hours of graduate coursework per summer semester.

**Graduate Research Assistants**

Graduate Research Assistants, including GRA-Project Assistants and GRA-Faculty Assistants, have additional conditions that may affect their registration requirements. GRA-Project Assistants must register for and complete a minimum of six (6) hours of graduate coursework per fall and spring semesters and three (3) hours of graduate coursework per summer semester. GRA-Faculty Assistants who are paid from non-restrictive Commonwealth funds must register for and complete a minimum of nine (9) hours of graduate coursework per fall and spring semesters and three (3) hours of graduate coursework per summer semester. Those who are paid from restrictive Commonwealth (S5) funds must register for and complete a minimum of nine (9) hours of graduate coursework per fall and spring semesters and six (6) hours of graduate coursework per summer semester.

**International Students**

For international students taking fewer than nine (9) hours of graduate coursework in either the fall or spring semester, a Reduced Course Load Request Form (RCL) must be filed with the Office of Visa and Immigration Service Advising (VISA). International students beginning a new academic program during the summer semester must register for and complete a minimum of six (6) credits, regardless of their funding source.

Please see Enrollment Requirements under the Graduate Assistantship policy for any exceptions to enrollment requirements.

- 6 A graduate teaching or research assistant who has completed a master's degree or its equivalent and is admitted as a matriculated student into a doctoral program and enrolls for and completes a minimum of 9 hours of graduate credit per semester or 3 hours in the summer may be granted a waiver of full tuition and fees.
- 7 Tuition and fee rate charged for Technology Delivered courses outside of Virginia and/or the United States.
- 8 Changes per Commonwealth Accounting Policies and Procedures (CAPP) Manual.
- 9 Waived for ODU alumni, ODU full-time faculty and staff, ODU full-time employee dependents, matriculated students from undergraduate to graduate, freshmen ATP fee waivers and certain transfer applicants with financial need certifications.
- 10 Applicable to students accepted in limited access health related programs (i.e., Physical Therapy). Fee is forfeited if student does not attend the program. This fee will be applied to the student's tuition balance.
- 11 Mandatory for F and J Visa holders and all nonimmigrant dependents.
- 12 Students participating in the experiential learning portfolio option will be charged a one-time workshop fee and a portfolio assessment fee equal to 50% of the current approved in-state, on-campus rate for undergraduate and graduate courses. - 18 Waived for Dental Hygiene Students, severely indigent individuals upon discretion of Director of Clinical Affairs.



- 19 a) Waived for ODU students majoring in Communication Sciences and Disorders, indigent individuals and individuals who "qualify" to participate in selected demonstration activities upon the discretion of the Communication Disorders Clinic Faculty.  
b) Treatment is prorated based on length of time per session.
  
- 20 The Foreign Language Test and off-site administration of the Miller Analogies Test are exempt from the test registration fee.
  
- 21 Minimum of two technicians for performance.
  
- 23 If an item is returned, the replacement charge and administrative fee are dropped, but fines are payable. - 26 Waived for students with full funding for room and board by government or independent agencies if they formally agree to take responsibility for damages.
  
- 27 Fee refundable if lease is canceled in writing and received in the Housing Office by May 1 for the fall semester and December 1 for the spring semester.
  
- 27B All students who receive an approved "Petition for Cancellation" will be charged the \$200 cancellation fee. The only exceptions for the cancellation fee are a) military service orders, b) graduation, and c) school sponsored activities that result in a required move from the area, ie. internship or study abroad.
  
- 28 Handicapped students, determined by the University to require a single room, shall be charged the prevailing rate for a student in a double-occupant room. Other students granted single rooms shall be charged the prevailing room rate for a student in a double-occupant room plus an additional \$800.00 per semester.

- 32 The New Student Transition Fee is a mandatory fee assessed to all new degree-seeking, non-distance undergraduate students and covers orientation and other transition-to-college programming. The fee is not subject to waivers.
  
- 33 The production fee is charged if the staff is required to produce a track of the advertisement.
  
- 34 Big Blue Tennis Memberships are available to Big Blue Club Members only.  
Members do not incur court fees, receive 4 guest passes, league discounts, reservation privileges, and additional privileges.
  
- 35 Blue Tennis Members receive 3 hour court fee credit, league discounts, and reservation privileges.
  
- 36 Court fees are charged for indoor courts only and are split among the participants using the court. Each non-member who does not possess a guest pass will also be assessed a \$15 guest fee in addition to their portion of the court fee.
  
- 37 For student groups recognized by Student Services and University departments, but who sponsor a non-University wide event (closed), as determined by the Director of the Student Center.
  
- 38 Cancellation fee would be 25% of the total cost for a ropes course event. - 43 Health Insurance program  
International Students - Enrollment is Required for all International Students (Graduate and Undergraduate)  
 International students with F-1 and J-1 visas are enrolled in the Student Injury and Sickness insurance plan upon registration for coursework. J-1 Scholars and F-1s on OPT are eligible to enroll. Costs associated with enrollment will be added to the tuition statement. International students that have questions regarding this process or wish to waive coverage or must contact VISA at intlstu@odu.edu for assistance.
- Domestic Graduate Students - Enrollment is Optional  
 All degree-seeking students enrolled in courses at Old Dominion University's main campus or one of the regional higher education centers are eligible to enroll themselves and eligible dependents. Enrollment is done online at www.uhcsr.com/odu. Look for the Enroll Online Now! link. Payment in full is required when you enroll.
- Graduate Assistants & Graduate Fellows  
 All graduate assistants earning a total of \$5,000 a semester or more from ODU, Research Foundation, or the Virginia Consortium in Clinical Psychology are eligible to enroll in a subsidized plan. The subsidized plan provides a taxable monetary subsidy paid to the graduate assistant. The subsidy is distributed mid-semester and will be part of the graduate assistant's paycheck. The amount of the subsidy varies and is determined on a semester basis. The amount of the subsidy for the 2021-2022 academic year is \$1,100. The subsidy is paid by semester, \$500 for Fall 2021 and \$600 for Spring 2022. Eligible graduate assistants can enroll online during the open enrollment period at www.uhcsr.com/odu.
- Graduate Fellows receiving \$5,000 or more from ODU are eligible to enroll in the subsidized plan. The amount of the subsidy varies and is determined on a semester basis. The amount of the subsidy for the 2021-2022 academic year is \$1,100. The subsidy is paid by semester, \$500 for Fall 2021 and \$600 for Spring 2022. Eligible graduate fellows can enroll online during the open enrollment period at www.uhcsr.com/odu. The subsidy will be paid through the Financial Aid office with distribution mid-semester.
- \*IMPORTANT: Please note subsidy payments are considered taxable income.
- 44 Sibling Discount  
 Siblings enrolled in the Center will receive a 2% tuition discount on the tuition of the oldest child enrolled at the CLRC.
- Monthly tuition is due no later than the 5th of each month. A late fee will be assessed on accounts with a balance due on the 10th of the month.
- Weekly tuition is due on Monday of each week. The late fee will be assessed on the 10th of the month for all weekly accounts that have a balance more than 5 days old.  
 Accounts not paid in full at the end of the month will be sent to University Collections and dismissal from the program will be instituted unless a payment plan is worked out with the director.

- 55 Study Abroad Program costs  
 Study Abroad Program costs for Faculty-led, Affiliated, and Exchange Programs vary depending on the program.
- International Insurance  
 Students, faculty, administrators and staff participating in credit or non-credit international education abroad programs, are required to carry comprehensive international insurance for the duration of their program. This cost will vary based on the nature and length of the program.
