


Undergraduate Scholarships

- → Proof of English proficiency (79 iBT, 6.5 IELTS)
- → Financial documentation (F or J visa)
- → Copy of passport identification page
- → Graduate requirements & deadlines vary among programs:
 - Standardized test results (GRE, GMAT, MAT, MCAT, PRAXIS)
 - Essay, personal statement, résumé, letters of recommendation
