

Respondus Installation Guide

Respondus is a powerful tool for creating and managing exams that can be printed to paper or published directly to Canvas.

If you have a prior version of Respondus or StudyMate installed on your computer, go to the Control Panel and **Uninstall** them from your machine. After doing so, restart your machine and then follow the steps below. (**Note:** Please review the [Quick Start Guide](#) for information about connecting with Monarch-Key Web Login in order to publish exams to Canvas.)

Install Respondus

1. Go to <http://odu.edu/ts/software-services/respondus> and select **Download Respondus**. Log in with your MIDAS ID and password.

Where To Get It:

Download Respondus on personal, non-managed Windows devices by clicking on the **download** button above. The .msi file will download after you log in with your MIDAS ID and password. If you already have Respondus installed but need to update the license and version, you only need to download the **updater**, rather than the entire software package.

On ODU-managed Windows computers, download the software from the [Ivanti Portal Manager](#) or [Company Portal](#).

On a Mac, you can access the software from the [Monarch Virtual Environment](#).

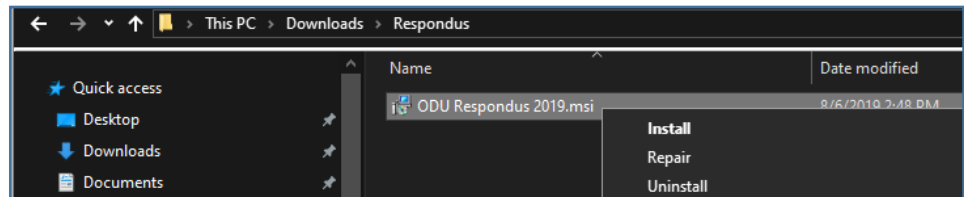
RESPONDUS UPDATER

This download is for personal, non-managed Windows devices. On ODU-managed computers, download the software from the [Ivanti Portal Manager](#) or [Company Portal](#).

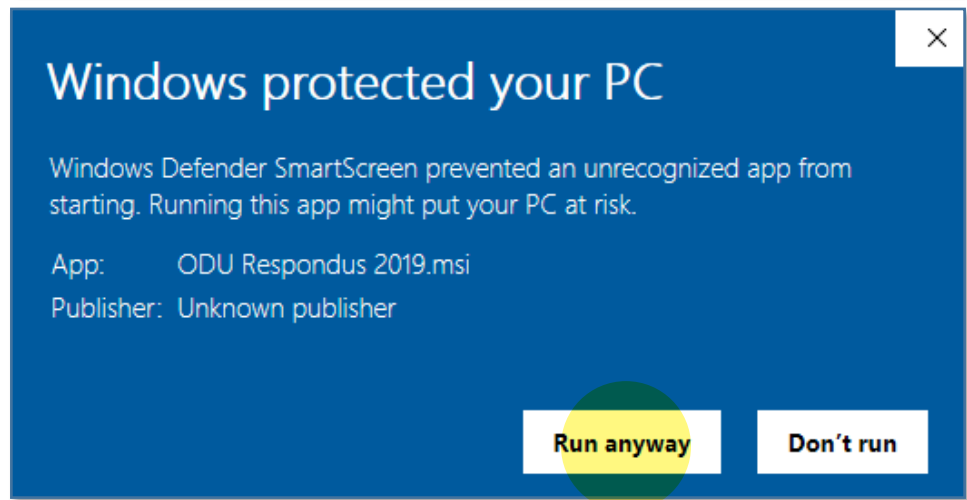
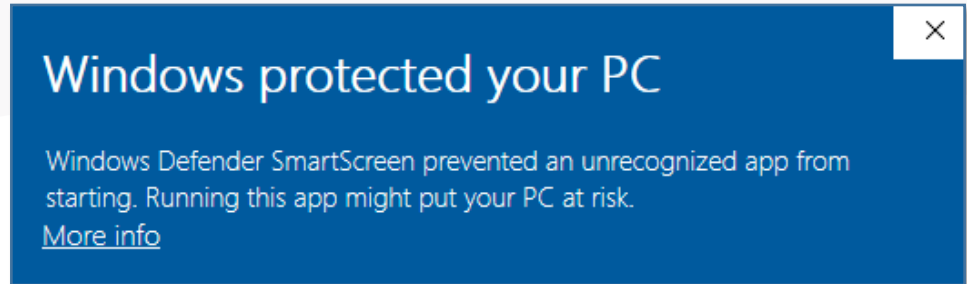

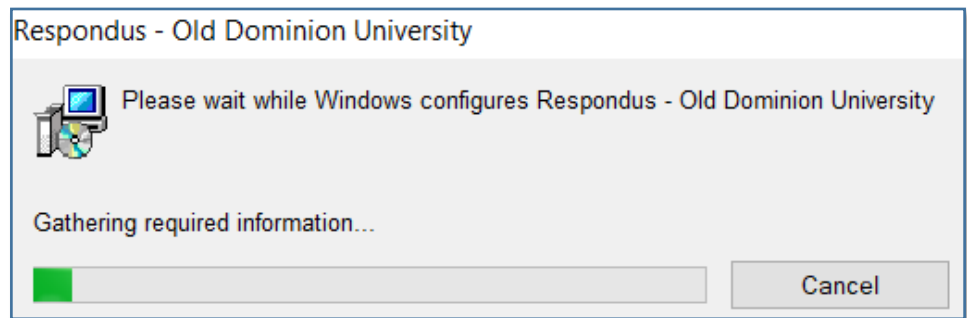
2. After the file downloads, navigate to your download location, right-click the Respondus Installation file, and click **Install**.



3. You may see either one of these messages from SmartScreen. If you see the first one, click **More info** to see the second. Then click **Run anyway**.



4. The installation will begin.



5. If prompted, enter admin credentials for your PC.
6. Respondus should now be installed and available for use.
