The subcommittee has met twice, reviewed what is already being done to support each area, the effectiveness of the efforts, and how the committee can contribute to overall success.

The following resources were identified: the University partnership with ReUP, Insight reports in Banner, DegreeWorks, Student Satisfaction Survey, Completion Advising, Junior/Senior enrollment and Course Offering of major courses.

Discussion of the most direct effect on the charge revealed that it should involve the students who have applied for graduation but are missing small requirements for degree completion. Chris Bowman provided a list of students who need extra support in the College of Sciences and Engineering. Currently, the newly appointed completion advisors are providing outreach to these students. Also, outreach is being done to students in those colleges that are not making the 2.0 major requirement. Chris Ricks provides consulting support with ReUp. Additional support that can be provided and maybe support STOP Out students that are not in their dataset. Elaine Dawson is assisting the committee with that data.
