Lesley Greene sends the following information about the Data Science Boot Camp that will be offered in May.

#### **Data Science Boot Camp**

This summer, May 8-13, the College of Sciences will hold its 2<sup>nd</sup> Data Science Boot Camp. This six-day intensive training course is designed to introduce the foundational elements of data science and artificial intelligence for Doctoral Graduate Students, Post-Docs, Research Professors, and Assistant/Associate Professors interested in learning more about this important and growing field. The boot camp will involve a combination of lectures and practical hands-on exercises and will be instructed by expert faculty from the Computer Science and Mathematics & Statistics Departments. If you attended last years boot camp, please note that this summer's program has several days of new topics that address Deep learning/AI.

## The main topics to be taught include:

- Day 1-2: Modeling for data science and machine learning
- Day 3: Data manipulation and data visualization
- Day 4-5: Deep learning/AI
- Day 6: Deep learning/AI applications

All trainees will also receive basic training in Python programming. Experience in programming is not required. Desktop computers will be available to all participants in the boot camp classroom. Course materials will be made available one week prior to the start of the camp.

#### Registration

Registration is open to first- and second-year graduate students in the Computer Science and Mathematics/Statistics doctoral programs, graduate students of any year in the other College of Sciences Doctoral Programs, Post-Docs, Research Professors, and Assistant/Associate Professors throughout the college.
