- *The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (concurrent/post-licensure curriculum) is designed for students who are registered nurses or concurrently enrolled in an AAS RN program. A separate application to the School of Nursing is required. This is a competitive program. Students must complete all lower-division general education requirements and nursing prerequisites before beginning the upper-level Nursing courses at ODU.
