I've asked Tiffany Whitfield to give an update on the website migration, Canvas license and more.

Website Redesign Project Update:

- ODU is still in the process of migrating from Adobe Experience Management (AEM) over to Drupal.
- The first wave of migrations is **nearing completion** which includes the College of Sciences including all of our seven departments. We are the only college and departments in the first wave ahead of all other colleges and departments.
- There are a total of seven waves as part of this content migration and the second and third wave have already begun.
- 50 sites have been competed
- Launched more than 2,500 pages
- The completion date for this entire project is currently set for the end of this calendar year.
- New website migration updates include: improved accessibility, design, structure, user experience and maintainability.
- There have been issues that have come forth during this migration. If you see information and directory page issues (not related to photos), email Tiffany and she will work with you to get it updated.
