In June 2024, the building and college were named the Ellmer College of Health Sciences a gift of \$20,000,000 thanks to a generous gift from Jan and Dennis Ellmer.

The building is a testament to our commitment to excellence and innovation in education, research, and service. About 2,700 health sciences students will use it throughout their collegiate experience. The first floor will also have space to host large events for the college as well as our community.

To date, \$23,226,275 has been raised toward naming opportunities for the new building.




