

What is the Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP)?

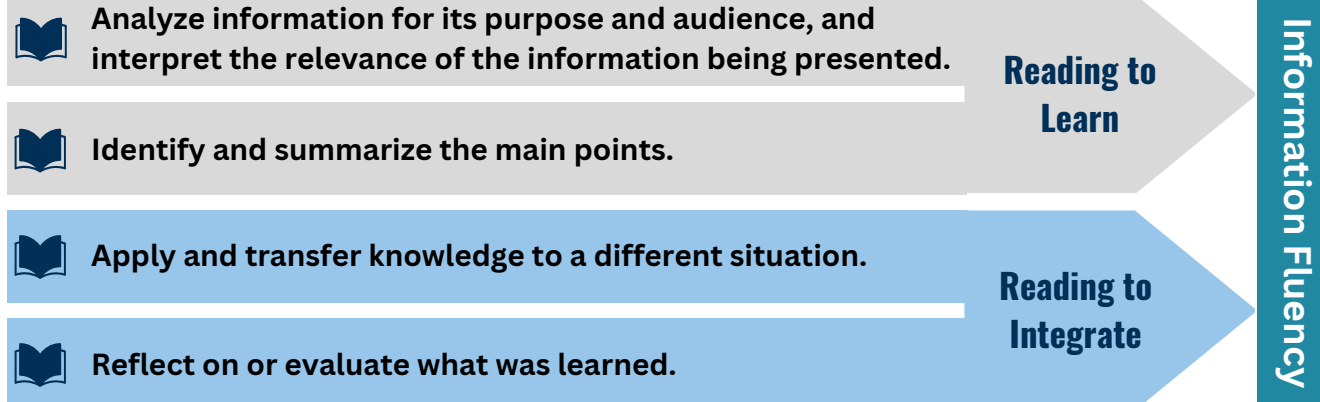
Every 10 years, ODU gets to make a major investment in a plan, the QEP, designed to broadly **enhance student learning**. QEPs are a unique feature of ODU being accredited by SACSCOC.

What is ODU's upcoming QEP?

PURSUE TRUTH: Read Responsibly. Think Critically.

How will the QEP enhance student learning?

Full-time faculty teaching 100- & 200-level courses will engage in workshops **to design assignments** that help students **read and think more critically**. Enhanced reading and thinking will help students improve information fluency, which is the ability to process and apply information in various contexts. **As a result of the workshops, students will be better able to:**



Each workshop of 24 participants has the potential to **reach 1,440 students, which could impact nearly 15,000 students' learning over 5 years!**

Following an early May 2023 pilot, 5-day workshops will be held once per spring and summer term. **Participants in the workshops will receive a \$2,100 stipend, plus meals.**
