

Notes (continued):

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- To qualify for the BSPH, Health Services Administration Professional major at Old Dominion University through the articulation agreement, students must qualify through licensure or certification and employment experience.
- Students must complete major declaration requirements listed in the University Catalog before officially declaring the Health Services Administration Professional major. Students who have met all major declaration requirements will be referred by their advisor in the Health Sciences Advising Center/ODU Online Health Sciences advisor to the program director for major declaration, program admission and assignment to a program advisor.
