- HRI 255+HRI 160+265 OR HRI 255+224+257 OR HRI 255+103+257 will be used to fulfill PRTS 350 requirement for the BS in PRTS, for this agreement only. Consult ODU advisor for substitution.
- HRI 196 & HRI 290 will be used towards hours reduced from PRTS 368 for the BS in PRTS, for this agreement only. Consult ODU advisor for substitution.
- These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html>: 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science; and 12 in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Interpreting the Past, Literature, or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide. \*These courses are beyond the completion of the AAS degree.
- HRI 180, required for the Event Planning specialization at TCC, will be used to fulfill PRTS 491 requirement for the BS in PRTS, for this agreement only. Consult ODU advisor for substitution.

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.

- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
