1. BS degree requires 3 credits: MTH 154, 155, 161, 162, 167, 245, or 261; if none of these options are taken, student will have to take a required 3 credit Math course at ODU.
2. Choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature or Foreign Language; and 3 credits in Interpreting the Past (History). Please consult with your TCC advisor to select the appropriate course.
3. MKT 100 will be used to fulfill MKTG 311 requirement and FIN 215 will be used to fulfill SMGT 331 requirement for BS degree at ODU.
4. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html>: 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science; and 3 in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Interpreting the Past, Literature, or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide. \*These courses are beyond the completion of the AAS degree.

Notes (continued):

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2024-2025 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2027, unless an updated agreement guide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: <https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs>.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
