If any excerpts or passages within are beyond your ability, you are still encouraged to audition and play as much as you are able.

All are highly encouraged to listen to professional recordings of excerpt repertoire with part in hand, studying such aspects as:

- Tempo (should ideally approach standard tempo, but always prioritize accuracy over speed)
- Rhythm
- Tone
- Articulation
- Phrasing

#### Violinists:

- You may choose any of the divisi lines in Excerpts 1 and 3. You are encouraged to prepare the upper lines if you would like to be given full consideration for first violin, but choose what you will be able to play confidently with accuracy and precision. (Note that the upper divisi line of Excerpt 1 and all of Excerpt 2 are common audition excerpts for professional orchestras.) Note that your choice does not necessarily guarantee your seating placement.
- Violinists interested in being considered for concertmaster should prepare the fourth Concertmaster solo excerpt as well.






