Disruptive Behavior Policy for Faculty and Faculty Administrators

Ensuring workplace safety is of vital importance. All members of the Old Dominion University community should foster productive working relationships. Disruptive behavior by any faculty member or administrator will not be condoned.

Disruptive behavior may include verbal threats, harassment, intimidating non-verbal actions, stalking, and other activities that interfere, with the safe and effective operation of the university. Faculty members and administrators who engage in disruptive behavior will be sanctioned under the appropriate standards of conduct policies.
