Health Professions Acceptance
in the School of Health Professions (SHP) will receive
their official admissions decision via the email address
provided on the application. To formally accept an offer
of admission, applicants must:
personalized URL (PURL) to electronically confirm their
decision to enroll
Program's Conditions of Acceptance and Technical
Standards within 10 days.
deposit if required
waitlists should be directed to the program.

School of Medicine Acceptance
Applicants accepted into the School of Medicine (SOM)
will receive their official admissions decision via the
email address provided on the application. To confirm
acceptance, applicants must:
two weeks of notification
Acceptance and Technical Standards
acceptance deposit of \$100 which will be applied to
tuition upon matriculation. In accordance with the
Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC)
recommendations regarding medical school acceptance
procedures, this deposit is non-refundable after April
30th.
