

First-Year Seminar (3 credits)

General Education Core (24 credits minimum)

Model A: Goals

Core courses are aligned with General Education Learning Goals rather than a subject area or discipline.

Learning Goals:

- Inquiry and Research
- Reasoning and Problem Solving
- Civic Engagement and Social Responsibility
- Communication and Expression

Model B: Pathways

Core courses are organized into pathways that align with themes or career-fields

- Example Thematic
 Pathways: National Security,
 Climate Change, Artificial
 Intelligence, Great Power
 Conflicts
- Example Career-Field
 Pathways: Health and Human
 Services, Design and Arts,
 Technology and Innovation
