Happy New Year, everyone! I hope this newsletter finds you well. We have a few exciting updates from our department!

The American Board of Emergency Medicine (ABEM) has, for the first time, released initial board certification pass-rate data for Emergency Medicine residency programs. I'm excited to report that **EVMS @ ODU Emergency Medicine is tied for #1 nationally**—out of nearly 280 programs—based on combined first-time pass rates on the Qualifying and Oral Certification Exams from 2017–2023. This time period effectively reflects more than a decade of our residency program's performance and serves as a testament to the exceptional dedication to excellence demonstrated by our faculty and residents. It underscores a sustained commitment by both our academic department and Emergency Physicians of Tidewater (EPT) to training the very best emergency medicine residents in the country! Congrats to all!

Second, we selected two outstanding first-year medical students for the EVMS @ ODU Accelerated MD Program (AMP). As a reminder, the AMP is a pathway that allows selected EVMS students to complete their medical degree in three years and, upon graduation, directly enter the EVMS @ ODU Emergency Medicine Residency Program.




