Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 overall and in the major and core program requirements, a grade of C- (1.7) or better in all departmental courses required for the major and the core program requirements, (some pre-requisites may require a "C" (2.0) or better), 120 credit hours, which must include both a minimum of 30 credit hours overall and 12 credit hours in upper-level courses in the major program from Old Dominion University, completion of ENGL 110C, ENGL 211C or 221C or 231C, and a writing intensive (W) course in the major with a grade of C or better, and completion of Senior Assessment.
