Title-of-Issue: Additional Revision to Modify Faculty Research and Development Policy on Teaching Coverage.

Description: Approval of Senate Issue AY21-8-G will not in practice have the effect intended without modification of (B.)2. in the Faculty Handbook policy on Faculty Research and Development Assignments.

Rationale: Based on 18 January 2022 Faculty Senate discussion and approval of Senate Issue AY21-8-G, it is my understanding that the revisions adopted to (D).1. in the Faculty Handbook policy on Faculty Research and Development Assignments were intended to allow Faculty Assignments of this kind to take place in circumstances when the courses which would normally be taught by faculty seeking such assignments are not taught by other full-time faculty.

To make this possible, as seems to be the intention of the Senate, changes must also be made to (B).2. in the Faculty Handbook policy on Faculty Research and Development Assignments, which reads in part ?The department chair must certify that the courses normally assigned to the faculty member will be covered by other full-time members of the department during the leave.?

I suggest that (B.)2. in this policy be reconciled with the stated intention of the Senate in approval of Senate Issue AY21-8-G by striking this sentence.
