



GRADUATE CERTIFICATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE LEADERSHIP

Our online graduate certificate in Community College Leadership is designed for emerging leaders in community college administration or administrators who have recently transitioned to a community college from careers in other industries.

Students take live, video online courses in the evenings during the fall and spring, then participate in an internship over the summer. Courses cover:

- institutional finance, fundraising, and resource management
- community college politics, policy, and advocacy
- curriculum, program development and quality assurance
- leadership and organizational strategy

The 15-credit program typically takes 1-year (2 courses per fall/spring semester) or about 2-years (1 course per fall/spring).
