

## **Minors in the Batten College of Engineering and Technology Civil Engineering Technology - Construction**

The minor in civil engineering technology – construction is open to all students (except civil engineering technology majors). The program consists of 12 credits and the specified courses are as follows:

The above courses are offered both on campus and through distance learning. For completion of a minor, a student must have a minimum overall cumulative grade point average of 2.00 in all courses required for the minor, excluding lower-level courses and prerequisite courses, and complete at least six hours in upper-level courses in the minor requirement through courses offered by Old Dominion University.

\*\*Other courses in the CET program at the 300-400 level maybe used, in lieu of or in combination with those above, for the construction minor upon written request and approval by the CET program director.
