The new Health Sciences building will be located at Monarch Way and 41st Street in Norfolk and will have 3 floors and 126,000 square feet. It will house our Sofia and David Konikoff Dental Hygiene Care Facility which provides oral preventive care services to over 1,860 patients and approximately \$80,000 in donated services.

The Sofia and David Konikoff Dental Hygiene Care Facility will increase from 30 to 36 dental cubicles. Each cubicle will be 165 sqaure feet and contain a patient treatment chair and related operatory equipment including computer technology to house digital radiography and use of the electronic healthcare records.
