## Honors in Geography (B.A. or B.S.)

Students must meet the minimum standards of the honors program, including the overall GPA of 3.25. Students wishing honors designation in the major for Geography fulfill all requirements for the given degree, BA or BS, and in addition, they must do the following (this does not increase the number of hours required for the major):

- a) Attain a GPA in the major of 3.5.
- b) Earn honors in nine (9) hours of courses in the major at the 300/400 level, with no more than six (6) hours taken from the same instructor. Independent study/internship courses are not eligible
