# Installing Microsoft Remote Desktop to Access MOVE (Mac OS)

This guide will assist you in installing Microsoft Remote Desktop to access the Monarch Virtual Environment (MOVE). Please make sure you are connected to the internet.

1. Go to the Apple App Store:

#### On your computer (**Apple Menu > App Store**)



#### Or on the web (www.apple.com/app-store)



2. Log in and search for **Microsoft Remote Desktop**. Click **Install** and follow the prompts. Once complete, click **Open**.

#### 3. When it opens, click Workspaces, then Add Workspace.





4. In the Add Workspace field, type https://rdweb.wvd.microsoft.com/api/ arm/feeddiscovery, then click Add. Wait while it searches for workspaces.



5. Sign in with your ODU email and click Next.





6. Enter the password for your ODU email and click **Sign in**.
