Our online doctoral program Community College Leadership has a strong reputation as an academically rigorous program that emphasizes executive-level leadership preparation. Students interact with some of the most important higher education leaders and policymakers in the U.S. while studying under the guidance of dedicated faculty members.

The 54-credit program typically takes about 3½ years to complete. Students take live, video online courses in the evenings during the fall and spring, then gather at our annual two-week Summer Institute. The course of study has four elements:

- core courses (21 credits)
- research courses (15 credits)
- cognate courses (6 credits)
- dissertation (12 credits)
