The Program Prioritization Task Force met electronically via Zoom on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 from 1:00-3:00 p.m.

Task Force members discussed one of the anonymous forms received since the last meeting. The faculty member who submitted the form asked whether the Task Force would investigate the distribution of resources and faculty lines in departments as well as faculty to student ratios.

The final Forum is scheduled for April 27. Brian Payne will begin the presentation and provide the background for the work of the Task Force; he may also show the template for the final report. Desh Ranjan will give an overview of the academic review process, and Wie Yusuf will describe the administrative review process. Nina Gonser will present financial information, and Mileta Tomovic will discuss the next steps going forward.
