Brian Payne reminded the group of the goals and tenets guiding the work of the Task Force.

One of the administrative subgroups presented its preliminary review of the following programs:

- Perry Honors College
- Strategic Communication and Marketing
- Center for High Impact Practices
- Center for Advising Administration and Academic Partnerships
- University Libraries
- Graduate School
- School of Continuing Education
- Academic Affairs Administration

Individual subcommittee members reviewed the materials and then met as a group to discuss their findings and various aspects of the rubrics. They made recommendations about modifications that might be made to increase the impact, efficiency or costs of the units.

Following the discussion, Task Force members felt it would be useful to have the mission statement and a business model for each unit. Brian Payne said that the Task Force can ask additional questions and asked members to think about any additional information needed or questions they have about each of the units.
