The University supports Microsoft Office Suites (Word, Excel, and PowerPoint). The School of Nursing requires all electronically submitted assignments to be in Microsoft Office Word. PowerPoint is used for student presentations. Microsoft Office Professional is available at student rate from the ODU Tech Store.

Students are required to communicate effectively (verbally and non-verbally) and prepare written documents that are correct in style, grammar, and mechanics. Oral presentations are required through the curriculum using a variety of methods including audio and video recording to a variety of audiences. Students must have access to audio and video equipment (i.e. smart phone) that can create files that can be transferred to a computer or uploaded to the web.
